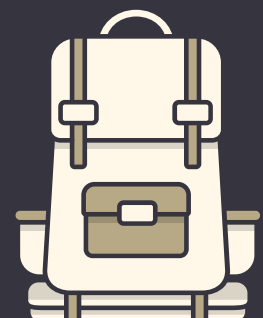

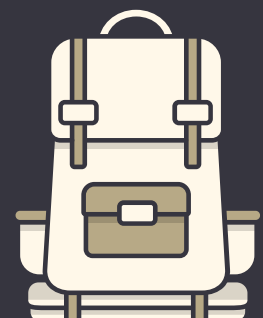

Naturalist-led Programs taught at your school or online:

3 R's- Reduce, Reuse, Recycle

Introduce your class to the importance of the "3 R's" and examples of them in their daily lives. Three interactive stations fully engage students with a project to do at home to ensure they remember what they learned! Ideal grade levels for this program are 2nd, 3rd, and 4th grades.

Reduction

Learn more about the first "R" as we explore ways to reduce the amount of materials we create and throw away on a daily basis. This class is great for 4th and 5th graders to help develop critical thinking skills during hands-on activities.

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
